
OUR MISSION

Innovation

We collaborate with the BYU 2ft Prosthetics engineering club at Brigham Young University and Engineering World Health at Cornell University to conduct innovative research and design of prosthetic limbs. We are constantly trying to improve our model to develop prosthetics that are high-quality, but practical for those in low-resource settings.



Distribution of prosthetic limbs

Each year we conduct projects in collaboration with local clinics to fit amputees with prosthetic legs who could not afford them otherwise. We also help amputees around the world who reach out to us directly by connecting them with our partner clinics and sending prosthetic components as needed.



Supporting local prosthetic clinics

We help establish new clinics or expand the capacity of existing clinics through trainings and equipment donations.






Number of Amputees Helped Per Year

Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic	August 12–27: We returned to ADR in Santo Domingo for our biggest project yet! Along with ADR employees and students from BYU and Cornell, we spent 2 weeks fitting over 60 patients. We hope to continue serving more and more people through this annual collaboration.	• 63 patients fit with prosthetic legs
Cebu City, Philippines	October 5-14: We began an exciting new project in Cebu City, Philippines. This will be an ongoing project over the next few years to establish a new clinic in the area, working alongside organizations like CharityVision, Mahubuay Deseret, DSWD AVRC, ArtLeg, and others.	 Screened 70 patients, fit 35 with prosthetic legs, and plan to finish helping all of them in 2024 Groundwork laid for a new prosthetic clinic







